In addition to attending this workshop on Sunday 18th September, coaches must also provide evidence of the following (note – #2 and #3 do not need to be completed prior to the workshop, but must be provided to Judo WA by Monday 3rd Oct) :

1. Have completed the AUSPORT online coaching course – register and complete this here www.ausport.gov.au/participating/resources/coaches/onlinecoach
2. Hold a current First Aid certification**
3. Hold a current Working With Children check
4. Be at least 17 years old and 1st kyu.
5. Be registered with JudoWA.

Note: In early 2017 a full NCAS Level 1 course for beginner coaches will be run by Judo WA. The JFA is currently developing a new NCAS programme (not yet available), however any coaches attending the Workshop on 18th Sept and meeting the additional requirements will be registered and their accreditation rolled over into the new system.

* All registered clubs are required to have at least one NCAS Level 1 coach.

** For those who need to renew the CPR component of their First Aid qualification, a course is offered at Kano Dojo at 10am on the same day as the workshop. Details to follow.
