**VENUE:**

The State Netball Centre is located at 200 Selby Street, Jolimont and is part of the Wembley Sports Park Precinct.

Entry to the Judo WA State Championships is via the State Netball Centre Reception.

**PLEASE NOTE:** There is an Australian National League netball game from 10am-12pm on 19 March. Signage will be set up at the venue to direct you to the Judo area.

**PARKING:**

Please ensure all cars are parked in designated parking bays directly opposite the State Netball Centre or further along on the far side of the outdoor netball courts. Parking on ovals, pathways and access ways is prohibited. The Town of Cambridge operates the car parks of the Wembley Sports Park and may issue fines.

**SPECTATORS:**

Spectator seating is available in the grandstand in front of the Competition mats. The small grandstand near the warm up area is not available.

**PLEASE NOTE:** No high heels are permitted on the wooden floor of the courts hall.

**FOOD AND DRINK:**

A Kiosk is available at the State Netball Centre which will have coffee, drinks and a small selection of lunch foods and snacks. Vending machines are also available.
